- Knowledge in the use of technology in worship: sound, lighting, computers, ProPresenter, PowerPoint, and video projection

Preferred Qualifications

- Experience leading worship in a similar church setting
- Some formal training in music (specifically church music)
- A music degree or equivalent experience
- At least five years' experience

Responsibilities

- Work with Senior Pastor to plan order of worship
- Lead the musical portion of worship services including congregational singing, choir music, orchestra, and special music
- Supervise/direct rehearsals for worship services
- Oversee tech ministry related to worship services
- Shepherd and communicate with volunteers in music ministry including leaders in Children's Choirs, Youth Choir, Celebration Choir (Sunday services), OASIS Choir (Older Adults Still in Service), and Instrumental Ensemble
- Encourage and mentor instrumentalists/vocalists, both adults and children, to step out of their comfort zones in praise and worship to the Lord
- Attend all church staff meetings and retreats
- Develop and work within an annual worship ministry budget
- Oversee the maintenance of all musical instruments owned by the church
